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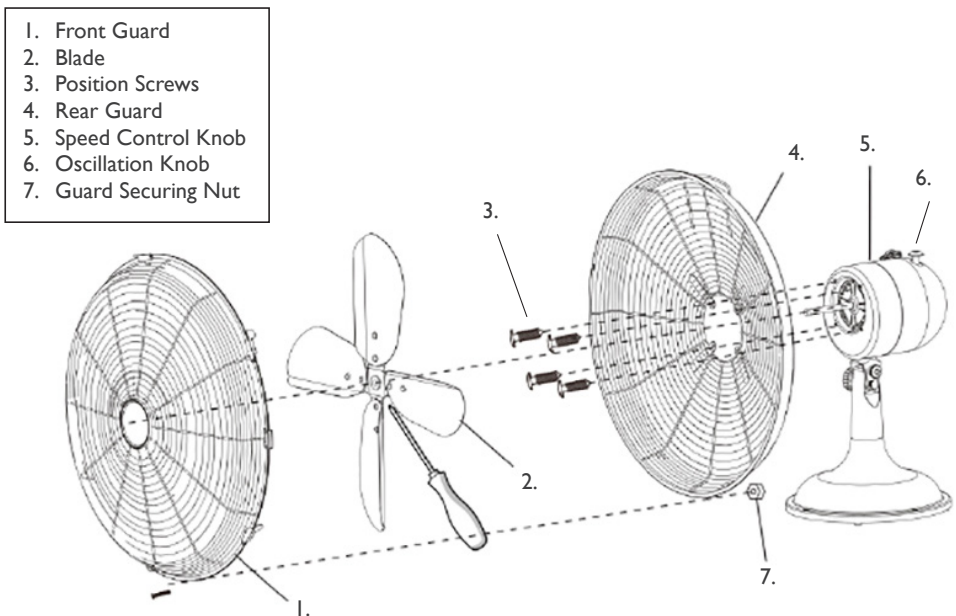
SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read this user manual carefully to ensure proper use, maintenance and installation.

1. This product is intended for domestic and light office use **ONLY** and not for commercial, industrial or outdoor use.
2. Do not operate the unit with a damaged cord or plug, after it malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any way.
3. All electrical repairs must be carried out by a qualified electrician. Inadequate repairs may result in a major source of danger for the user and invalidate the warranty.
4. Make sure the voltage in your home corresponds to the one shown on the rating label of the appliance.
5. This unit should always be kept in an upright position especially during operation to avoid any damage. Locate the unit on a flat stable surface.
6. Position the power cord where people will not step on or trip over it.
7. Ensure that the air inlets and outlets are not blocked or covered.
8. Do not place the unit too close to curtains or other objects - min 30cm.
9. Never insert fingers, pencils or other objects into the unit. Warn your children against these dangers.
10. This appliance should only be used by adults.

11. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children.
12. Children shall not play with the appliance.
13. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children.
14. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge.
15. Unplug the unit from the socket when not in use. Do not pull on the cord.
16. Do not use the unit near a bath, shower, swimming pool or anywhere it could be splashed with water.
17. Do not expose the unit to direct sunlight.
18. Do not use the unit near flammable or explosive gases.
19. Before cleaning or moving the unit, switch it off and unplug the power cord.
20. Do not leave the unit unattended during operation.
Always unplug the power cord when not in use.

APPLIANCE OVERVIEW & ASSEMBLY



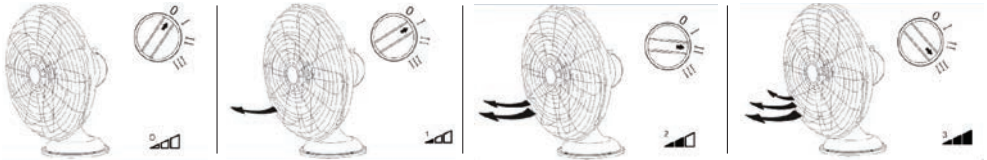
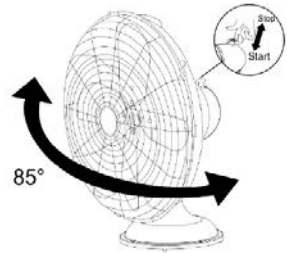
MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove all parts from the packaging. Separate the front and rear guard.
2. Align the rear guard with the four holes on the motor then insert and tighten the position screws.
3. Slide the blade onto the shaft of the motor and tighten the securing screw onto the flat of the shaft to secure the blade. Ensure that the blade does not touch the guards.
4. Assemble the front guard to the rear guard. Tighten the connecting screw and nut and secure the retaining clips.

DO NOT OPERATE THIS FAN WITHOUT THE BLADE GUARD SECURELY FITTED

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Check that the mains voltage complies with the voltage stated on this product.
2. The On/Off switch is incorporated in the speed control switch on the side of the fan.
 - 0 - Off
 - I - Low Speed
 - II - Medium Speed
 - III - High Speed



3. Push the Oscillation control at top of the motor housing to turn on the oscillating function. Pull the oscillation control up to turn it off.
4. The fan head can be adjusted up or down. To do this loosen the adjusting knob, adjust the fan to the required angle and secure the adjusting knob again.

Warning: The fan must be placed on a flat even surface. When you turn off the fan, switch to OFF on the base. Switch off at the mains and remove the plug. Ensure that the fan will not be obstructed when oscillating.

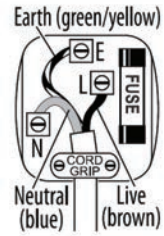
CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

1. Turn off the fan and remove the power plug from the wall socket before cleaning.
2. Use a dry soft cloth to remove any dust from the fan.
3. If the fan is particularly dirty use a soft damp cloth and wipe dry.
4. Do not use any chemicals or detergents as they will damage the fan.
5. Ensure that water does not drip into the motor housing.
6. Store the fan in a ventilated and dry area.

MAINS PLUG FUSE REPLACEMENT

Fuse Replacement (Class I)

This appliance must be earthed. Remove the central screw on the plug and open the shell. Take out the fuse and replace with a new fuse of the same Amp. Install the shell again and tighten the screws.



TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE

| Problem | Possible Cause | Possible Solution |
|------------------------------|--|---|
| The appliance does not work. | The appliance is not properly plugged into the wall socket. | Plug the appliance in firmly. |
| | The appliance is not switched on. | Make sure the appliance is switched on. |
| | There is no electricity running through the mains wall socket. | Check the fuse or breaker. |
| The appliance is too noisy. | Sitting unevenly. | Ensure fan is sitting on a flat surface. |
| | Not secured together correctly. | Make sure all components are secured correctly. |
| The air speed is too fast. | Fan setting is too high. | Adjust setting accordingly. |
